












Chairman's Address



In the face of the unprecedented challenges brought about by the pandemic and the subsequent lockdowns, CREDO demonstrated remarkable resilience and compassion. We swiftly pivoted our focus to address the urgent needs of those affected, providing crucial supplies such as masks and other essentials to communities in distress.



CREDO was committed to fostering social responsibility and community development by partnering with a diverse network of over 364 NGOs from across the country. These NGOs are specialising in Child & Youth Education, Health Awareness, Skill Development, Social Service. This initiative was offered free of charge, reflecting CREDO's dedication to inclusivity and support for organizations that worked tirelessly for the betterment of society.



By affiliating with these NGOs, CREDO aimed to create a collaborative platform that opened doors to a myriad of opportunities for those who trulv deserved them—individuals and communities that were often overlooked or under represented. This network not only enhanced the reach of CREDO's mission but also amplified the grassroots organizations making impactful changes in their localities.

Completion of Entrepreneurship Training

The training, which began on September 2, 2019, and concluded between January 31 and February 29, 2020, saw ten talented young women from various backgrounds join the program. Each participant was provided with comprehensive instruction in creating a range of products, including fabric files, bags, shirts, baby trousers, and more, as well as learning techniques such as screen printing. The trainees were also introduced to advanced items like aprons, fridge covers, gloves, caps, doormats, and mobile charger covers. Rotary Club of Calcutta Chowrenghee had donated 3 tailoring machines to CREDO while the cost of training was sponsored by CREDO.

On March 30, 2020, CREDO - Confederation of Rehabilitation. Empowerment, and Daedal Organization proudly reported the successful conclusion of its entrepreneurship training program to 10 under priviledged girls of recommended by the Rotary Club of Calcutta Chowrenghee. The program, part of the 'Mission SWABHIMAAN' initiative, aimed to empower underprivileged young women by providing them with essential skills in tailoring and garment manufacturing. Held at CREDO's fashion incubation center at Tangra, Kolkata. The training focused on equipping participants with the latest technology and best manufacturing practices to foster entrepreneurial capabilities.



Among the trainees, Rani Hela and Preeti Singh particularly stood out, demonstrating remarkable enthusiasm and dedication. They excelled in their training, achieving high scores in both eagerness and skill acquisition, and produced diverse creations such as baby shirts and wall hangers that reflected their comprehensive learning. In contrast, Zainub Yasmin showed more modest progress, primarily acquiring skills in making bags and screen printing.

The successful completion of this training program highlights the impactful partnership between CREDO and the Rotary Club of Calcutta Chowringhee, showcasing the potential for significant social empowerment through targeted vocational education. As these young women venture into the world with their newly acquired skills, they carry the promise of self-reliance and entrepreneurial success, paving the way for their future in the fashion industry.

This program not only transforms their individual lives but also contributes to broader social change, inspiring hope and opportunity for many in their communities.



Chowrenghee-CRED

Rotary Calcutta Chowrenghee joins CRE-DO (Confederation of Rehabilitation Empowerment & Daedal Organisations), in the IC-SURE incubation project for training, employment and empowerment of the underprivileged through bespoke garment manufacturing. Our club has given 2 automatic Japanese Juki tailoring machines on which 10 girls have started training to stitch bespoke shirts.

Training will take place in 2 batches of 4 hours for 5 days/week. Training period is for 6 months during which they will receive a stipend matched with a bonus upon completion of training, after which they will be upgraded from interns to junior tailors & then a master tailor & entrepreneurship.

CREDO DURING THE PANDEMIC







The pandemic posed significant challenges, particularly for underprivileged communities that often lacked adequate resources. In response, CREDO committed to providing comprehensive support to those in need, focusing on urgent health needs and societal welfare through targeted interventions. Our initiative included the free distribution of lifesaving medicines and PPE kits certified by the Ordnance Factory Board to protect medical staff. We also distributed face masks widely and donated ten imported oxygen concentrators, establishing oxygen banks in Tangra, Kolkata, and Durgapur, Bardhaman, to improve access to essential supplies during critical times.

Additionally, we empowered underprivileged communities through vocational training and economic support.

- In Topsia, we offered free apparel training for women, helping them gain valuable skills.
- We distributed fabrics and garments at the Ramakrishna Mission Sarada Seva Kendra in BagBazar- Kolkata, enabling recipients to sew accessories and pursue self-employment.
- In Barrackpore, we assisted in establishing a garment manufacturing unit with the Sarada Mission, promoting local industry and job creation.
- We also enhanced the Ramakrishna Mission's Food and Beverages products with advanced packaging to improve market reach.

CREDO has been actively involved in Covid-19 response efforts by creating educational content on sanitization, providing medical kits to affected areas, and free online courses on Covid care protocols.

On March 22, 2020 her husband died of a kidney disease. As a single mother, she used to wash dishes and prepare mid-day meals at a local school surviving on daily wages. Today, the school is under lock down so her prospects of earning her daily bread has evaporated with it. Ashwini has a baby and is in trouble today. For her to survive this ordeal and fulfil her basic needs, Ashwini needs a hand.



CREDO is pioneering a policy to extend its membership drive sustainable social through This empowerment projects. initiative includes establishment of informal English language and computer education classes in Topsia. These classes aim to foster independent thought, enhance public speaking skills, and support character development. At the age of 14, students will be introduced to CREDO's Vocational Training Centers, where they will receive skills training to prepare them for productive societal roles.





On Valentine's Day, CREDO chose to spend time with children from underprivileged backgrounds, emphasizing that if children are the future of a nation, it is our responsibility to ensure that even the poorest have opportunities comparable to their more privileged peers. Street children, when given a chance, often show remarkable intelligence and eagerness to learn.





Sunderban Kultali Village Initiative

In the Sundarban region, where the male population has been significantly diminished due to tiger attacks while foraging in forests, CREDO is launching employment projects to reduce dependency on forest resources. Initiatives include fisheries and mud crab culture, village honey farming, online education for children, driver, plumber, and carpentry training, as well as adult literacy programs. These projects aim to create sustainable villagebased employment opportunities, minimizing the need hazardous forest excursions.



MASS EMPOWERMENT

Mass Empowerment Project in Bengal

CREDO has proposed a comprehensive mass empowerment project for Bengal, highlighted by a vision video designed to promote widespread empowerment. The project includes developing merchandising for marketing CREDO's initiatives West Bengal distributina free CREDO-branded apparel. Additionally, CREDO Center's video content, showcasing its vocational training, manufacturing, and service capabilities, has been made available on social media.

The Rural Empowerment Program video, along with a detailed 1,500-page project report, covers scientific farming, greenhouse farming, rural industries, warehousing, and cold storage, forming an integrated model to revive the rural micro-economy.

CREDO Center of Excellence:

Operated by the vision of CREDO Foundation, a non-profit charitable trust founded in 2019—has been established with a contribution of ₹ 4 crores by Pinaki Roychowdhury, the founder of CREDO Charitable Trust. This centre focused on providing free training, employment opportunities, and assistance entrepreneurial to underprivileged individuals, helping them secure a sustainable livelihood. The team, comprising Anwar Mullick (Production Head), Puja Santra (Fashion Designer), and Nabanita (Fashion Designer), was on a mission to explore opportunities for transforming the Vocational Training Centre into a hub for fashion design, manufacturing, accessories. This vision aimed to create an empowered ecosystem that bridges the rural-urban divide and fosters opportunities for all through a unified fashion incubation model.

The team was warmly received by Mr. Ayush Agarwal upon arrival in Durgapur, who provided exceptional hospitality. The unit hosted 24 trainees equipped with 16 traditional manual sewing machines. The team conducted an introductory session to demonstrate the scope of fashion design and showcased images related to the field.

The trainees were assessed through basic tasks, such as creating small bags from leftover fabric, reflecting their design ideas.

The session proved productive, with all trainees demonstrating eagerness to learn. Moving forward, CREDO recommended that five trainees would be selected for upskilling through an intensive 30-day training program at CREDO's Behala and New Alipore Centers in Kolkata.

Upon completion, the trained and certified fashion designers will return to their home base to establish a Self-Help Group (SHG) and commence operations. CREDO will support and guide their entrepreneurial journey, encouraging them to secure stitching orders from Neo Metaliks. These orders may include eco-friendly fabric envelopes, industrial uniforms with customized elements, corporate gifts, and display items for casual and formal wear.

TAILORING PROJECT BY CREDO

Under the **PM-Vishwakarma Scheme,** CREDO empowers skilled tailors across India by providing semi-automatic, straight-stitch sewing machines and comprehensive tool kits to designated training centers. Each toolkit, including essentials like bobbins, scissors, seam rippers, tailor's chalk, and measuring tools, is organized in sets of three for efficient distribution.

In collaboration with AMHSSC, CREDO utilized a nationwide delivery network to ensure timely delivery within 3-4 days, with updates on dispatch and arrival statuses. Warehouses strategically located across India stored 1,600 kits (totaling 4,800 machines and accessories) with secure electrical connections and insurance for safe transit. This initiative reinforces CREDO's commitment to sustainable skill development and self-reliance for artisans nationwide.

- CREDO deployed 250 personnel exclusively for this project's success.
- CREDO **directly handled the installation** of all machines at each location.
- Comprehensive documentation, including dispatch, tracking, and installation details, was maintained in a shared drive.
- Each installation was accompanied by **photographic demonstrations** to ensure thorough documentation.

This project by CREDO Center of Excellence achieved nationwide impact, delivering essential sewing equipment to **300 locations across India, from remote forests to mountainous regions.** Despite challenges, CREDO ensured that each center received the tools needed to empower skilled tailors and artisans, reinforcing its commitment to self-reliance and sustainable livelihoods.






